

Jesus is what angels are not

Hebrews 1:4-14, p. 967

- I. ANGELS ARE NEVER CALLED “SON” BY GOD (HEBREWS 1:4-5).
 - A. Jesus’ name (nature) is infinitely superior to angels (1:4).
 - B. Jesus is called Son by the Father (1:5).
- II. ANGELS ARE NEVER TO BE WORSHIPPED (HEBREWS 1:6-7).
 - A. God declared that angels must worship Jesus the Son (1:6).
 - B. Angels are simply servants of God (1:7).
- III. ANGELS WILL NOT REIGN ON A THRONE (HEBREWS 1:8-9).
 - A. The Father declares that the Son will reign forever (1:8).
 - B. The Father set Jesus the Son above the angels (1:9).
- IV. ANGELS ARE NOT ETERNAL (HEBREWS 1:10-12).
 - A. Jesus was in eternity past and created all things (1:10).
 - B. Jesus will remain forever when all else perishes (1:11-12).
- V. ANGELS DON’T HAVE GOD’S AUTHORITY BUT ARE SENT BY GOD AS SERVANTS (HEBREWS 1:13-14).
 - A. Angels do not have authority at God’s right hand (1:13).
 - B. Angels are sent by God to serve believers (1:14).
