

What faith looks like when it's tested

2 Chronicles 20

- I. Pray in faith (2 Chronicles 20:1-13).
 - A. Experiencing crisis – Moab and Ammon attacked.
 - B. Jehoshaphat inquired of God.
 - C. Jehoshaphat prayed a God-focused prayer.
 - God's power, faithfulness, justice
 - Our need and complete inadequacy

- II. Listen to God's promises in faith (2 Chronicles 20:14-17).
 - A. God says, Don't be afraid or discouraged.
 - B. God says, Stand up and see what I do.
 - C. God says, Face your problems – I'm with you.

- III. Worship in faith (2 Chronicles 20:18-21).
 - A. Jehoshaphat and other leaders worshipped in anticipation.
 - B. Jehoshaphat declared his faith in God publicly.
 - C. Jehoshaphat and the people thanked God in advance.

- IV. Act in faith (2 Chronicles 20:22-25).
 - A. God worked the miracle as they worshipped.
 - B. The people experienced God's power first hand.

- V. Celebrate the fruits of faith (2 Chronicles 20:26-30).
 - A. Judah worshipped God in grateful reflection.
 - B. Judah experienced the long-term impact of Jehoshaphat's faith.
