

Humility toward one another

Part #2 – Life together (the one anothers')

- I. Jesus Christ is all-important as head of the church.
 - A. God appointed Christ head over the church through which God is present in the world (Ephesians 1:22-23).
 - B. Christ is the cornerstone of the church, the temple where God dwells and receives worship (Ephesians 2:20-22).
 - C. Christ must be glorified by the church (Ephesians 3:20-21).
- II. We glorify Christ who is our Head as we act in humility toward one another in the church.
 - A. Submit to *one another* in reverence to Christ (Ephesians 5:21).
 - B. Regard *one another* as more important than yourself (like Christ – Philippians 2:3; Romans 12:10).
 - C. Clothe yourself with humility toward *one another* (1 Peter 5:5; “Wash *one another’s* feet” like Christ – John 13:14).
